



Former Deerstands USA Tower Blind Customer,

We would like to take this opportunity to introduce you to our new company, **Second Creek Deer Blinds, LLC.**

I'm betting that our background may be similar to yours. Before starting Second Creek Deer Blinds we were avid deer hunters who had purchased and loved hunting in Deerstands USA's tower blinds. In fact, we have six of their tower blinds spread out on our Missouri farm. Two seasons ago we tried to buy additional tower blinds, only to learn that Deerstands USA was no longer in business. We were then forced to purchase other tower blind products that were available in the marketplace, only to be deeply disappointed in their construction, quality, quietness, and general huntability in comparison to the tower blinds that we already owned.

After two seasons of fruitless searching for a new quality tower blind, we took the approach of contacting Deerstands USA and pursued purchasing the design and manufacture of their tower blinds. After much investigation and discussions with Glen Trunko, we reached an agreement to purchase their tower blind designs, manufacturing equipment, production jigs for all of the tower blind models and have even employed their production manager to work in our facility.

Our product line will consist exclusively of the following models:

- 4' x 6' Tower Blind Model
- 4' x 6' Tower Bow-Blind Model
- 4' x 4' Tower Model

Each of these models will be available in either a 15' or 18' height configuration (legs and diagonal supports). These are the EXACT models produced by Deerstands USA except that we have added a 29" vertical safety grab-bar to the left of the door openings to make it even easier to enter and exit our blinds safely.

Our manufacturing facility is located at 1916 Highway 50 in Drake, Missouri which is about 45 miles east of Jefferson City, Missouri and about 60 miles west of St. Louis, Missouri. We have all three models on display at our manufacturing facility. Give us a call to set up a time where you can stop by and compare

all three models side-by-side. Many of you may not have previously seen the 4' x 6' Bow Blind model, as that was the last product introduced by Deerstands USA.

Since we were not able to start our production runs until late in the summer, there will be limited product availability in 2007, but we will be able to satisfy all orders in 2008. Also, until we complete several large production runs, we're holding as close to the 2004 prices as we can for all sales made in 2007, whether they are delivered in 2007 or 2008. By the end of December we will evaluate current material and production costs and reset our prices for all orders placed in 2008.

Features for All Three of Our Tower Blind Models

- 4 Acrylic drop down windows (side opening for bow blind) for a complete 360° view
- Insulated roof to help retain heat
- Removable ladder
- Welded door latch, hinges and window bolts (no bolts to work loose)
- 8" leg pad to keep the Tower from sinking into the ground
- 4 leg anchors that are driven into the ground thru the leg pad
- 4 legs made from 1 ½" 11 gauge steel tubing
- 8 diagonal braces
- Center anchor, center anchor stakes, center anchor cable and clamps
- Treated plywood floor
- Large door opening
- *New* 29" vertical safety grab-bar for a solid hold while entering and exiting the platform
- Reinforced roofing-rubber covering for the entire platform that is extremely QUIET and durable
- Fully assembled platform (if you've bought other tower blind products currently on the market you understand the full day saved with this feature!)

This letter is being sent to all customers of Deerstands USA who have previously purchased one of their Tower Blinds. Since you have bought this product before, you understand our product and will have the first opportunity to purchase the same product under a new name. By the end of September, we will be bringing up our new web site and will make the tower blinds available to the general public.
